

NORTHWESTERN ALL-SPORTS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP
- SELECTION PRODECURE -

- A committee consisting of the High School Athletic Director, an officer of the All-Sports Association, two members of the All-Sports Association and a regular classroom teacher, as appointed by the All-Sports Association, shall meet to select the recipients of the annual scholarships.
- The number and amount of the scholarships will be determined each year by the Northwestern All-Sports Association. All application information and deadlines will be announced through the NHS Athletic Department.
- The recipients of these scholarships will be announced at the senior awards assembly.
- Please note that student-athletes may apply for this scholarship and either of the Athletic Department's Memorial Scholarships, but only receive one of the previously mentioned scholarships (i.e. applicant cannot receive both the Boatner Memorial and the All-Sports Scholarships).

The selection criteria shall be:

1. Must be a senior at Northwestern High School.
2. Must have participated in sports for all four years of high school.
3. Must have earned at least one varsity letter.
4. Must have been accepted at an institution of higher learning.
5. Must compose an essay on why applicant should receive the scholarship.

The following evaluation system will be used:

Essay: 50 points possible

Seasons Participated In: 5 points each

Varsity Letters Won: 2 points each

Grade Point Average: 4.40+ = 15 points

4.20-4.39 = 14 points

4.10-4.19 = 13 points

4.00-4.09 = 12 points

3.80-3.99 = 10 points

3.60-3.79 = 9 points

3.40-3.59 = 8 points

3.15-3.39 = 8 points

3.00-3.14 = 6 points

2.90-2.99 = 5 points

2.70-2.89 = 4 points

2.50-2.69 = 3 points

2.30-2.49 = 2 points

2.00-2.29 = 1 point
